CROATIAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATS

The party "Social Democrats" was created in 2022 by the split of the Social Democratic Party of Croatia. 18 deputies out of a total of 30 left the SDP and formed their own parliamentary club and then the "Social Democrats" party. One of the main reasons for the split was the support of the party leadership for the President of the State, Zoran Milanović, who is best known, even in European circles, for supporting the Russian invasion of Ukraine. Milanović was the president of the SDP from 2007 to 2016 and managed the party with authoritarian methods, which is why a huge number of members left the SDP earlier. His destructive political activities affected the entire left. In addition to the SDP, which became an authoritarian pro-communist legacy party, the protest party "Možemo" was also created on the left, even more radical in its views and actions. "Mozemo" is a combination of green activists and far left groups.

The party "Social Democrats" represents classic social democratic values and stands for a democratic and legal state, protection of human rights and freedoms, market economy, care for the socially vulnerable, fight against corruption, etc. The party's president is 66-year-old Davorko Vidović, former Minister of Labor and Social Welfare in the Government 2000-2003, mayor of Sisak and long-time member of parliament. However, the key difference between the "Social Democrats" and other parties of the left: SDP and "Možemo" and the ruling HDZ is that the Social Democrats, compared to the aforementioned parties, are sincere advocates of Euro-Atlantic integration, meaning continued meaningful cooperation and membership in the EU and NATO.

Russian aggression against Ukraine will show how Croatian political actors understand their obligations towards NATO. Although the majority of the public supports Ukraine in its struggle, a significant number of political entities, for various reasons, support Putin and Russia. In February of this year, during the vote on the Government's proposal to organize training for Ukrainian soldiers in Croatia (within the EUMAM mission), which required a two-thirds majority of votes, the "Social Democrats" were the only opposition party to support the government's proposal. The other two parties of the left (SDP and Mozemo) and the opposition parties of the right, followed the position of President Milanović and voted against the proposal, which was therefore not adopted.

In the coming year, three elections await Croatia: in the spring there are elections for the European Parliament, then in the summer (if not earlier) elections for the Croatian Parliament and in December the elections for the President of the country. In the coming period the "Social Democrats" will join the gathering of other responsible political parties and the formation of a pro-Western left-center coalition is planned.
